
## VEJAR'S 2017 JOG-A-THON

Our 7th annual Jog-a-thon will be held on Thursday, March 30, 2017.

It is an important event for our school with the goal of earning money for the Vejar Community Club, which helps sponsor school enrichment programs that are not in the school budget. This year, the entire proceeds from the jog-a-thon will be used to help pay for Project Lead the Way (PLTW)!
